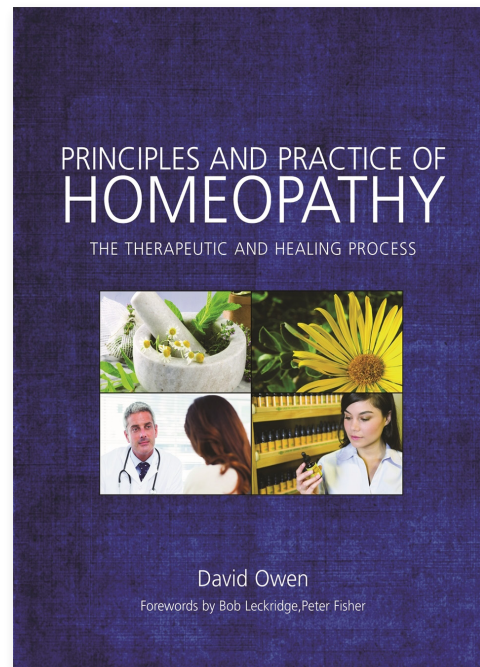

Each theme is woven together through the text and, section by section, builds into an essential study guide for the homeopathic student.
